1. Approval of minutes

Motion: Approve minutes from January 19, 2024. The motion was unanimously approved.

2. Dean's Dissertation Award

The EC reviewed the current announcement for the purpose of improving its clarity and ensuring the nomination process is fair to all PhD candidates.

- May a student who has been awarded a PhD be nominated?
 The current language states, "Nominees must be a Ph.D. candidate at the date of submission of the nomination." This was intended to be a minimum requirement, not to exclude those awarded a PhD.
- PhD candidates scheduled to graduate in the fall semester are provided two nominations periods, whereas spring semester graduates are only provided one opportunity.
 - It was agreed that new language will be drafted that clearly defines the two nomination windows so all students, independent of their graduation date, have the same opportunity to be nominated.
- The current announcement does not exclude a student from being nominated twice. Candidates can be nominated only once.
- When a student is eligible to be nominated should be more clearly defined.
 The debate centered around "candidate" versus "scheduled to graduate".
 Nominees must be a Ph.D. candidate or awardee or at the date of submission of the nomination.

Dianne will draft a new announcement, share it with the committee, and then a vote on the new language will take place at the next meeting.

Kelli will prepare an email to the school directors informing them that PhD awardees may be nominated this semester.

3. ASU and OpenAl Collaboration

Continue discussions around OpenAI and opportunities for the recently announced partnership. Questions for Executive Committee discussion:

- 1. What are innovative uses of the partnership that would help faculty? Specific ideas that would inform an FSE proposal are strongly encouraged.
- 2. What questions do you have about the partnership and potential uses?

SCAI would like to take leadership on this task. Pitu will coordinate a request to SCAI faculty for input.

"ASU AI Innovation Challenge" request for proposals was communicated to faculty this week by Jayson Johnson.

We will continue discussions on this topic in our next meeting.
